State of the Ridge Address:

2025 promises to be a good year for the golf course. 2025 should bring some of the best course conditions ever seen by the golf course. The staff has worked hard to continue to make improvements. 2024 was a difficult weather year due to the extreme drought conditions, which we are continuing as of the time of this writing. The course fared well through the difficult times.

We now have timers at all the irrigation boxes. These units will need to be programed, but this should allow for the automation for the first time in over 10 years. This will be a real time saver. We did have issues with our irrigation pumps as two of them were not running at full capacity. These will be pulled in the off-season for repairs.

In 2024, Timber Ridge was able to acquire new Club Car Tempo golf carts. This was a great addition to the course. As members, I would ask that you help police how the carts are driven. The staff tries to keep every cart accounted for, but two did slip through the cracks this year with someone damaging the new carts without being able to determine who the damaging party was. Please help with this task. It is not out of line to let someone know that as a member you do not appreciate how they are driving the cart or where they are driving the cart.

In 2025 we will continue to work on the cart paths, greens, tees and fairways to make them as good as possible within the budget constraints of the golf course. In the 100-year history of the golf course, profitability has been achieved very few times. Your continued support is appreciated. The vision of Timber Ridge is to become one of the nicest public courses in the area and become profitable enough to spread the workload of the course maintenance across a staff of people rather that 1 or 2.
